

The following information, compiled for you by InterFaith Works CNY, will assist you to more easily visit hospitalized congregants. The Clergy Parking Card fee of \$25 a year, entitles you to unlimited free parking at Community General Hospital, Crouse Hospital, St. Joseph's Hospital & Health Center* and Upstate Medical University Hospital. *The Clergy Parking Card is not authorized for personal use.*

Community General Hospital: Community General Hospital is open to the public during visiting hours, 12 noon to 8:30 p.m. (ICU & Maternity Wards have more restricted hours). No patient lists by faith or congregation are available to outside visiting clergy due to HIPAA laws. At the request of the patient, Community Hospital will notify the patient's clergy person that they are hospitalized and would like a visit. Only members of the Pastoral Care Department team are allowed free access to visit patients. *The Clergy Parking Card is valid at the Community General Hospital parking garage.*

Crouse Hospital: To enter Crouse Hospital to visit a patient, clergy and pastoral care visitors, as well as the general public, are asked for the name of the individual they wish to visit. The security officer will then issue a visitor name tag which is good for one visit only. At the request of the patient, Crouse Hospital will notify a patient's clergy person that they are hospitalized and would like a visit. No patient lists by faith or congregation are available to outside visiting clergy due to HIPAA laws. Only members of the Pastoral Care Department are allowed free access to visit patients. It cannot be used at the CNY Medical Center parking garage on the corner of Irving and Waverly Streets.*

St. Joseph's Hospital Health Center: Pastoral Care Visitor Badges are issued by St. Joseph's Hospital to ordained clergy and pastoral associates who frequently visit church members. With this badge, you do not have to stop at the Information Desk to receive a printed visitor pass each time you visit. To apply for a badge, ask for an application at the Information Desk in the main lobby. All clergy and pastoral associates are asked to sign the register at the Information Desk when they visit patients. At the request of the patient, St. Joseph's Hospital will notify an individual's place of worship that they are hospitalized. No patient lists by faith are available to outside visiting clergy due to HIPAA laws. A list of current patients by place of worship may be obtained at the Information Desk by a clergyperson presently serving a congregation. To request that a list be made available for your congregation; contact the Pastoral Care Office at 315-448-5116. **All clergy may park for free (with or without a Clergy Parking Card) in the new parking garage off North Townsend Street. Parking tickets are validated at the operator's desk, which is located in the hospital lobby. Clergy identification and/or ordination credentials may be requested for validation.*

Upstate Medical University Hospital: Upstate welcomes clergy and pastoral visitors as part of their commitment to provide spiritual care to patients and their loved ones. Please bring a photo ID, and the name of the person(s) you plan to visit, and you will be issued a day visitor's pass. The Center for Spiritual Care contacts congregations upon admission at a patients or families request. HIPAA laws do not allow access to patient lists. Please stop by the Center for Spiritual Care, located in the main lobby of Upstate. You are welcome to hang up your coat, use our phones, or Hospitality Room for private pastoral consultation. Please contact us at 315-464-4687 or www.upstate.edu to leave referrals. Our first floor Interfaith Chapel and 12th floor Golisano Children's Hospital Treehouse Chapel are always open for prayer. Roman Catholic priests are invited to record Sacraments in the Sick Call book, located on the main desk of the Center for Spiritual Care.
