Instructions for Selling Raffle Tickets for the 2018 Duck Race to End Racism

Thank you for agreeing to help us raise awareness and money for our 16th Annual Duck Race to End Racism.

## Here's the process:

- 1. Ensure EVERY ticket has your organization name clearly written on the bottom of the ticket stub in the Non-Profit Partner section. This is very important for us to correctly attribute your ticket sales to your organization.
- 2. Place the Duck Race posters in a prominent place, with your "Ticket Sales Contact Person's" information.
- 3. Have ticket purchasers fill out the tear-off section completely & legibly, and return this small portion to you with their \$5.00. You will turn in the tear off sections along with the money. Checks can be made out to InterFaith Works, with "Duck Race tickets" written on memo line.
- The purchaser can keep the larger portion of the raffle ticket as a reminder of the event date, time and location. Note: Ticket Holders Do Not Have to Be Present to Win!
- Tickets and money must be turned in to CFD by 2:00p.m. on Wednesday, June 6 in order to qualify for the \$1,000 "Power Paddler" drawing.
- Within a few weeks after the Duck Race, CFD will issue your organization a check for your half of the sales. (Tickets and money *MUST* be turned in TOGETHER to ensure that your organization receives the accurate 50/50 split.)
- If your group sells the most tickets, you will win an extra \$250.
