While this event was created to support, uplift and empower Black Men and Boys, it takes our entire community to make the impact we desire and need. We want the diversity of support and participation to mirror the wonderful diversity of the Syracuse community and Upstate NY as a whole. Regardless of race, shade, creed or gender we

are counting on the entire community to come out in a powerful display of solidarity in Central New York and surrounding area's.

THE MARCH: (THIS IS A SOCIALLY DISTANCED EVENT. MASK MUST BE WORN TO PARTICIPATE.)

We envision Black men and boys marching through our city streets in unity starting from City Hall and ending at the county court steps. There we will be greeted by men and women of all races to show solidarity in their support and encouragement of Black men taking a stand for their communities. Participants will purposefully fill the steps of the Onondaga County Courthouse. Pledge cards will be given out. The pledge will include the following...

7 Guiding Principles: I. Atonement 2. Community 3. Family 4. Economics 5. Education 6. Housing 7. Health

Our guest speaker will take the platform to deliver a powerful keynote address and then he will transition into the pledge portion of the event. Our keynote speaker will lead all in repeating the Black Man's Pledge/Oath. The pledge will be facilitated by 7 faith & community leaders, each addressing one of the 7 principles. At the conclusion of the pledge ceremony we will then have a moment of silence for 8 minutes and 46 seconds in honor of George Floyd, and all of those killed at the hands of police brutality. He will then address our purpose, needs, and access to the resources for our Action Plan.
